Dear Parents/Guardians of Secondary One Students,

WELCOME TO TERM 4 2024

We hope that your teen had a meaningful and restful September holiday, and you were able to spend some quality time with him/her. As we enter the final term of 2024, we would like to provide you with key updates and information on events/programmes in Term 4 for our Sec 1 students.

A. CCA Matters

1. CCA activities have stood down from **Tue 20 Aug** to help students to prepare for the End-of-Year Examinations. CCA activities will resume from **Fri 11 Oct**.

B. End-of-Year Examinations

2. The End-of-Year (EOY) Examinations for Sec 1 students will take place in Weeks 3-4, **Mon 23 Sep** to **Mon 7 Oct**. Please refer to the notification sent on **Mon 26 Aug** via Parents Gateway for the detailed End-of-Year Examination schedule.
3. Teachers have informed students of the topics tested for their EOY Examinations and the formats of the papers for each subject. The details have also been put up on class notice boards as well as sent to students via Google Classroom.
4. As part of revision, practice papers will be provided to help students familiarise themselves with examination format/demand and build confidence. These practice papers may be administered during lessons or as homework. Subject teachers will instruct and guide the students accordingly.
5. While examinations is one main avenue for teachers and students to assess learning progress, they are not the be-all and end-all of education. We look forward to continuing to partner with you to nurture the joy of learning in our students, support their holistic development, and help them see examinations and tests as opportunities to surpass themselves.

C. Bowen October FIESTA (End-of-Year Post-Examination Activities)

D. 3-Day Conversational Chinese/ Malay (CCM) Programme

- Our Mother Tongue Language (MTL) Department will be conducting the annual Conversational Chinese/Malay (CCM) Programme. CCM is an established MOE programme that introduces Conversational Chinese or Conversational Malay to students who do not speak the language (e.g. to Malay or Indian students / to Chinese or Indian students respectively). Through CCM, students will gain a basic understanding of the respective languages, to enable them to strengthen bonds with their peers as well as operate comfortably within the region.
- For students who will be signing up for the programme, it will be conducted from **Mon 28 Oct** to **Wed 30 Oct** in school, from 8.30am to 12.30pm. Further details on CCM will be given to students by their MTL teachers at a later date.

E. Other Matters and Overview of Activities

9. Report Books for Sec 1 students will be issued on **Fri 25 Oct**. Parents/guardians will not generally be invited to meet Form Teachers (FTs); but if you would like to talk to the FTs, you are welcome to contact them directly. FTs will be calling or arranging for face-to-face/video conferences with parents/guardians of selected students to provide feedback on their child/ward's progress and development.
10. The year-end school holidays are scheduled from **Sat 26 Oct 2024** to **Wed 1 Jan 2025**. The last day of school will be **Fri 25 Oct**. In addition to the CCM programme for Sec 1 students, teachers may ask students to return to school to provide additional support for students who need it, between the last week of October and second week of November. Students involved and their parents/guardians will be notified.
11. To allow our students more time and space to rest and recharge, Student Protected Time will be from **Wed 20 Nov** to **Sun 15 Dec** (both dates inclusive) during which there will not be any school activities (e.g. no CCA activities).
