Dear Parents/Guardians of Secondary 3 students,

WELCOME TO TERM 3 2026

Welcome back! We hope that you were able to make the most of the June holidays to spend quality time with your teen as well as encourage him/her to reflect on their Semester 1 learning experiences. We are very proud to share that Bowenians continue to make a positive impact and have been recognised at various platforms, most recently at the Shell NXplorers Global Inspiration Awards (Outstanding Student Team, out of more than 200 nominations from 10 countries), as well as at the Festival of Deeds by Kids, where another team received the Community Champion Award from former President Mdm Halimah Yacob for the most user-centric youth led social innovation. To further enhance our efforts to develop Bowenians as global citizens and support internationalisation outcomes, the school will also be hosting 3 educators from Sweden and Norway in Term 3 under an exchange programme in partnership with NIE. The school is also continuing its campus rejuvenation efforts, which will include upgrading the school toilets and air conditioning our hall. B. Update on Health Matters

4. The school continues to prioritise student health and remains vigilant in checking in on student well-being. Your support is also crucial towards keeping Bowen a safe environment for students. Please remind your teen to practice good personal hygiene (e.g. washing/sanitising hands) and exercise personal and social responsibility. While mask-wearing is no longer required in a school setting, it remains an effective way to minimise the risk of infectious disease transmission. Students who prefer wearing masks are welcome to continue doing so.
5. If your teen is unwell, please ensure he/she stays at home and seeks medical attention if necessary. Do also inform his/her FTs. If your teen is recovering from respiratory-related illness, please encourage him/her to exercise social responsibility (e.g. by wearing a mask, minimising social interactions). Social responsibility will be crucial in preventing any infectious disease outbreak in schools. In the event your teen has to miss school, his/her learning will be supported. FTs will assign a buddy to update your teen on the lessons and collect his/her learning materials. Please encourage your teen to be proactive in finding out on what he/she has missed from his/her buddy.

D. Experience ITE Programme

8. The Experience ITE programme aims to introduce Secondary 3 students offering predominantly G2 subjects to the skills training available at the ITE colleges and enable them to better identify their interests and start planning for their post-secondary education. Students will also be given the opportunity to try out a range of fun, hands-on activities which will not only provide insights but challenge their creativity.
9. This programme will be conducted from 8.30am to 4.00pm at ITE College Central on **Thu 20 Aug**. Two-way transport will be provided.

E. External Safety Validation

10. The school will be undergoing an External Safety Validation (ESV), on **Thu 2 Jul**. The ESV is facilitated by MOE personnel and helps schools to strengthen their safety and security processes, which in turn enhances the safety and well-being of all students and staff. As part of this validation, MOE personnel will be observing the school's safety and security processes throughout the day, including traffic management processes before the start of school. They will also be speaking to students and staff about their understanding of these processes.

12. Students have been updated through their FTs before the start of Term 3 and will be reminded on attire matters on **Mon 29 Jun** during morning assembly. The school will review whether to adjust this provision based on the prevailing weather conditions.

13. In addition, our staff will continue to closely monitor students during physical and/or outdoor activities. Students will also be encouraged to hydrate themselves before, during and after activities.

G. CCA Stand-down for Sec 1-3

14. CCA for Sec 1-3 will stand down after **Tue 25 Aug**. CCAs will resume activities from **Fri 9 Oct**.

H. Start of Term 4 and End-of Year School Holidays

15. Term 4 will begin on **Mon 14 Sep**. A separate letter will be issued to inform parents/guardians about the schedule for Term 4.

16. The year-end school holidays for S1-3 is scheduled from **Sat 24 Oct 2026** to **Fri 1 Jan 2027**. Teachers may request for selected students to return to school to provide additional learning support and/or for CCA. Students involved and their parents/guardians will be notified beforehand. Student Protected Time will be from **Sat 21 Nov** to **Wed 16 Dec** (both dates inclusive) during which there will not be any school activities (e.g. no CCA activities).
