Do


- Approach a trusted adult and seek his/her help. Have a conversation with this person about what would be best for you.

- 1. JAE registration will open from 4.00pm on Thu, 11 Jan 2024 to 4.00pm on Tue, 16 Jan 2024.
- 2. All course registration must be done online through the JAE Internet System (JAE-IS) accessible through the JAE website at https://www.moe.gov.sg/post-secondary/admissions/jae/during-application/submit-application
- 2. Applicants can access JAE-IS with your SingPass.

- 5. Applicants should note the following:
 - a. You should use the **JAE Worksheet** before accessing the JAE-IS to register your course choices. Completion of the JAE Worksheet will enable applicants to register more smoothly online.
 - b. You are strongly advised to make full use of the 12 choices, where applicable. The choices should be listed in the order of preference. (you cannot repeat course choices)

JAE Posting Results

The JAE posting results will be released on Thu 1 Feb 2024 through the following modes:

- JAE-IS, which you can assess using your Singpass
- Short Message Service (SMS) to the Singapore mobile phone number provided by the applicant during the JAE registration



JAE Posting Results

JC or MI

If posted to a JC or MI (on Fri 2 Feb 2024), report to the school on the morning of the next working day after the release of the posting results, in your secondary school uniform.

• If you are unable to report to their posted JC or MI on the first day of school due to valid reasons, please contact your posted school directly to confirm that you are taking up the place, and the school will be able to reserve the place for them.



JAE Posting Results

Polytechnic

If posted to polytechnics, you will <u>receive an enrolment email or card</u> <u>sent to your residential address. It contains instructions on the enrolment process.</u>

ITE

If posted to an ITE course, you will receive an email with the enrolment instructions.



Appeal Exercise

JC or MI

Students who wish to appeal for a transfer to a JC/MI should approach the JC/MI directly. [must meet Minimum Entry Requirement and JC's COP]

Polytechnic or the ITE

Students who wish to appeal for a place in polytechnic or ITE Higher Nitec course may do so online, through a combined polytechnic and ITE Higher Nitec appeals portal at *jaeappeal.edu.sg*

Students who were not posted to any course during the JAE are also encouraged to submit an appeal through the same portal.

Results of the appeal will also be released through this portal.

Appeal Exercise

- Students must meet the minimum entry requirements for admission for the courses.
- Appeals are evaluated on a case-by-case basis and a place may be granted only when compelling reasons are presented, and vacancies are available.
- Students must report to the institution they are posted to or accept the course offer online while waiting for the result of their transfer application.

Key Messages for JAE

1. Consider your course choice wisely

- 2023 Cut-off Points (COP) for the JCs/MI & Minimum Entry Requirements to Polytechnic courses under my School Finder or Course Finder
- In the JAE, applicants are posted to a course based on merit according to their net aggregate scores, taking into account the various bonus points eligible for (i.e. net L1R5 for JC course, net L1R4 for MI course, net ELR2B2 for Polytechnics courses and net ELB4/ELR1B3/ELR2B2 for ITE courses).
- It is important that you should consider courses that are comparable to your aggregate scores, for better fit and better chances of being admitted.

Key Messages for JAE

2. Make full use of your 12 choices

- Make a considered decision of all 12 choices because there
 is a change that you will be posted to one of them.
- Do check that you qualify for the course you are applying for.
- If you do not use up the 12 choices, you are limiting the number of choice you have in where you could be posted.

- 2. If you are unable to complete the application via the Joint Admissions Exercise Internet System (JAE-IS), submit a request for assistance using the JAE Request form (JAE Request Form will only be available from 4pm on Thu 11 Jan 2024 to 4pm on Tue 16 Jan 2024.)

Appeal for Review of results

- 1. Candidates may apply to appeal for a review of their results.
- 2. All appeals by candidates together with the payment of appeal fees must be submitted through schools by **Wed 17 Jan 2024**
- 3. Inform Mrs Chan or Form teachers if you wish to do so.



Certificate Amendment Request

- Candidates may request for a re-print of their current exam year certificate only if their name has been printed wrongly due to misspelling.
- Administrative fee: \$50 (inclusive of GST)
- Inform Mrs Chan/ Form Teacher by Wednesday 17 Jan 2024 for school to submit request.
