

## **AForte Elective Module Programme for Secondary 4 NA and 4 NT students**

1. Your child/ward will be attending a 4 days Elective Module (EM) Programme on **7, 9, 10 and 11 January 2019** (Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday).

2. The aims of EM are to expose students to possible careers that they may wish to pursue in the future, and to provide them an opportunity to experience actual practices used in the industries.
3. In 2018, your child/ward was given the opportunity to indicate his/her interests. After consolidation, your child/ward will be attending one of the five Elective Modules below:
- DJ & Hosting (Music)
  - Healthcare & Nursing
  - Photography
  - Food Culinary (Desserts)
  - Tourism and Hospitality
4. We have allocated the EMs taking into account the students' choices, within the number of places offered by each EM. Nonetheless, we will work with the students to make the most of their learning whichever EM they are allocated.
5. The EMs will be conducted based on the timing indicated above for all the four days. Students will report to school at 7.30 am as usual in school attire. The EMs will be held in school and external venue(s) related to the EMs. More information will be provided to the students nearer the programme date. We seek your support in encouraging your child/ward to attend all four sessions and participate actively in all the activities. At the end of the EM, your child/ward will present / showcase what he/she has learnt, to practise his/her presentation skills. He/she will also receive a certificate of completion.
6. As the Ministry of Education (MOE) subsidises a large part of the cost (actual cost : ~\$300), students will only be paying the remaining amount of \$50. This \$50 can be paid through their Edusave account. Students without an Edusave account or have insufficient funds in their Edusave account, payment can be made by cash or Giro deduction. Form Teachers will notify these students through the school bill.
7. Your child's/ward's attendance for this programme is **compulsory**. Should he/she miss any of the sessions without a valid medical certificate, disciplinary action will be taken against your child/ward and he/she may be liable to pay the full course fee.
